## Nursing Foundation Lab

Nursing Foundation Lab is aimed at helping the students to acquire knowledge, understanding and skills in technique of nursing practice. The 1600sqft spacious lab is well equipped with patient simulators, CPR mannequins, life form hand simulator etc. Three sides of the lab are lined with 12 hospital beds holding “patients” (mannequins) dressed in hospital gowns with a pillow, a blanket, an over bed table, a bedside table, a bed side locker, infusion



stand and a bed screen for privacy. Teachers use this area to demonstrate and students can practice in this area. In the center of the room is a seating area with movable tables to enhance visibility for any number of students.

## Advanced Lab

The advance skill lab aims at teaching and training students the essential advance nursing skills to provide overarching care for adult patients suffering from variety of disease conditions. It prepares nursing graduates qualified in the care of the adult patient according to the highest standards of nursing care. This lab also provide hands on learning experiences specific to course objectives as directed by the nursing curriculum.



## OBG and Pediatric Lab

Obstetrics and gynaecological laboratory is designed to make students gain knowledge and techniques to the real situation procedures. It is well equipped with instruments, fetal skulls, maternal pelvis, forceps, dummies for mechanism of labor, models for normal and abnormal labor mechanism, flowcharts of obstetrical care and principles and charts to provide every possible knowledge related to obstetrics and gynaecological nursing. It allows the students to assume same situation as in clinical setting to make them competent in technical skills with proper use of scientific principles.

## CHN Lab

Community Health Nursing lab is a miniature of community setting be it be a rural or urban. It is a simulated home environment that allows nursing students to practice their community health skills in a life like scenario. Our CHN lab is therefore an extension and expansion of the ideal guidelines of nursing. It has all the necessary measures, equipments that will thereby help our students to face any challenges in the community

## Nutrition Lab

Nutrition Lab is equipped & well furnished with utensils & nutritional charts. It is well ventilated with proper lighting & adequate water facilities. The students can assess the nutritional needs, caloric requirement of different age groups and during various disease conditions.

## Procedure for Hostel Admission

- ★ Student should submit the complete and properly filled up application form.
- ★ Parents/legal guardians of students are required to appoint a responsible person as a local guardian to the satisfaction of the authority
- ★ The students have to be accompanied by their parents/legal guardian at the time of admission.
- ★ The local guardian will represent the parents/ legal guardian and take charge of the student in case of prolonged/serious illness, unforeseen emergencies, holidays and vacations.

## Rules & Regulations of Institution

1. Candidate got admitted should abide by the rules and regulation of the Institute, hostel and concerned University /Council.
2. Those found disobeying the rules and regulations shall be debarred from the hostel and college.

3. Ragging in all forms in the nursing institution is strictly prohibited by the order of supreme court. The institution will take immediate appropriate action in this matter.
4. The students are required to attend the classes in prescribed time table & in uniform.
5. The students are required to attend the lectures, tutorials, clinical duty & field duty regularly.
6. A student has to attend at least 80% theory classes & 100% practical classes to be eligible to appear in the internal examination & also university examination.
7. Attendance in all classes (Theory and Clinical) is compulsory, a student may be debarred from appearing all examination including university examination on the ground of shortage of attendance.
8. The students & guardian will be informed through a letter before she is debarred for appearing university examination due to shortage of attendance before examination.
9. College will not take any risk & responsibility for any problems raised by students residing outside the hostel.
10. A student is not allowed to receive gifts or gratuity of any sort at any time from the patients or their relatives.
11. Students must participate in all college activities like clinical meetings, conferences, guest lectures, seminars as well as sports, cultural activities etc.
12. Student are required to carry their identity cards during college hours, clinical posting & whenever they are going out. The ID card must be produced whenever it is asked by the concern authority.
13. Students are required to sign in the register every time when they leave hostel premises and return.
14. No visitors are encouraged during working hours of the college/hostel other than the allotted time.
15. Visitors are not allowed to go to the student's room.
16. No guardians are allowed to meet their children in the hospital and other clinical fields.
17. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during College hours & Field posting.
18. Salwar Kameez & long skirts are only permitted inside the Campus.

# Rules & Regulations of the Hostel



1. The institution will not be held liable directly or indirectly, for the loss of any personal properties due to theft or any other cause.
2. Student should bring own lock & key for their rooms.
3. Turn off light, fans & water taps when not in use.
4. All students are responsible for cleanliness of their rooms.
5. Deposit all waste & rubbles in the waste bin provided.
6. Rags, papers must not be thrown in the rooms, terrace or in the hostel premises.
7. Boys are not allowed to enter into the girls hostel.
8. Students are not allowed to arrange any group religious activities in their rooms.
9. Students who wish to stay back in the hostel on working days for whatever reason, need to take prior permission from the warden/authority.
10. During regular working days, students have to report back to the hostel by 06.00 pm.
11. Hostel warden will take attendance at 07.00 pm to ensure that the students have reached in the hostel.
12. Proxy attendance is not allowed, all students must have to report for roll call attendance.
13. Students shall take prior permission out pass from the warden go to outside the campus & inform to the warden after their arrival at the hostel.
14. On holiday or Sunday students need to take an outpass signed by the warden stating the purpose, time of departure & expected arrival time.
15. Students are not permitted to own any motor vehicles on campus. They may use bicycles but the safety & storage of bicycles is the owner's responsibility.
16. Students shall treat the hostel & mess staffs respectfully. They should not demand any special service from them.
17. Students should not be loitering in the verandas.
18. Cooking of any kind in the room is strictly prohibited.
19. Students shall have their food in the dining hall only.
20. Ragging is a crime & punishable offence.
21. Every student should switch off light after 11 pm.
22. Students are required to maintain silence in the hostel
